
Exhibit Cancellation

Meeting Demographics

Typically 500-600 people attend AIC, representing 110-140 institutions, primarily in the upper Midwest (see diagram below). Our annual trainee (graduate students and postdocs) attendance averages 65%.

Approximately 90% of our attendees in 2023 resided in the midwestern states shown. Out-of-region registrants represented 14 states, and 6 foreign countries.
